# Category: Field Hauler - Truck Driver (Custom Combine Operation)

#### **Category description:**

Drives truck or tractor with trailer attached as part of a custom combine operation to gather and transport wheat and grain. Drives truck or tractor with trailer attached to gather and transport harvested crop in field: hauls trailer alongside crew loading crop or adjacent to harvesting machine and regulates speed to keep abreast of crew. Hauls loaded trailers from field to highway or packing shed, uncouples trailer, couples empty trailer to tractor and returns to field. May haul crop over public roads to storage shed or processing plant.
